

Training & Employment

- The Senior Community Services Employment Program (SCSEP) improves job readiness of mature workers while expanding the services of local nonprofit and government agencies by providing paid, part-time job training to adults ages 55 and over.

- *Job Club* provides training in job readiness, resume building and jobseeking skills via a complimentary three weeks of classroom training.

- *Encore Career Network* is a social enterprise model that draws upon the expertise, passion and talents of people ages 50 and over in Cuyahoga County who are assigned to paid, part-time positions at nonprofit and government agencies.

Nutrition and Wellness

- *Meals on Wheels* offers homebound and disabled clients nutritious meals conveniently delivered to their home.

- The *Senior Farmer's Market Program* distributes vouchers to qualified clients to purchase fresh fruit and vegetables each summer at local farmer's markets.

- Our *Emergency Food Pantry* assists those in need with three days of food every thirty days.

- The *Health and Services Fair* was launched in 2016. Over 600 people received Farmer's Market vouchers and 200 people were provided access to other services, including food donated by our partner, the Akron-Canton Regional Foodbank.

Avenues to Recovery

- Our *Avenues to Recovery Program* focuses on individuals ages 50 and older struggling with addiction to alcohol, other drugs and/or mental health issues. We provide treatment and tools to help clients improve their health and lives.

Homecare Solutions

- Our Home Health Aides provide non-medical, hands-on care including bathing, dressing, feeding, walking or using a wheelchair. Homemaker services include housekeeping, laundry, shopping, and meal preparation, while our chore services supply deep cleaning services.

- 16,758 hours of home health aide services
- 6,652 hours of homemaker services
- 228.75 hours of case management services
- 326 nurse visits for wellness assistance
- 162 clients received 958 hours of chore services
